Transition towards Collaborative Organizations 5.0

Scope

The Special Session welcomes *theoretical, empirical* as well as *pragmatic contributions* on topics like: collaborative network modalities to support 5.0 innovation & transition; collaboration & communication requirements for and in Organizations 5.0; experimentation of hybrid human-AI collaborative networks supporting 5.0 transition; experimentation and simulation of collaborative networks supporting 5.0 transition; assessment and maturity levels of collaborative capabilities in 5.0 Organizations; role of digitalization and AI capabilities in Organizations 5.0; management of collaborative networks 5.0.

All other contributions that relate to the main field of collaboration in Organization 5.0 are also very much appreciated.
